His topic for the evening was to discuss what he considers to be the basics of turning.

Stuart then led us through a discussion on the basics. The basics he mentioned were: grain orientation, using proper chucking, sharp tools, tool rests, speed and rpm's, stance, and lastly tools.

Stuart discussed the above basics and demonstrated most of them during the night. He also emphasized the importance of having your bowl gouges at what he called 40 degrees and 40 degrees and explained the importance of having the bevel 40 degrees and the wings at 40 degrees.

After the discussion and demonstration the wood rafel was held and the meeting ended.

The Willamette Valley Woodturners will be holding their first Pen Exchange at the November meeting. I have participated in 5 or 6 pen exchanges through Sawmill Creek (http://www.sawmillcreek.org/forum.php) and the International Association of Penturners (http://www.penturners.org/). I have greatly enjoyed making pens for these pen exchanges (they are both currently having their pen exchanges) and I thought it would be fun for our club to do a pen exchange. What I will be doing is bringing in a box at the November meeting and anyone who has made a pen will place their pen in the box and receive a ticket. Then at the end of the meeting, you will redeem a different pen from the box with your ticket. We want the pens to be wrapped so that it will be kind of a grab bag when you select a pen from the box. You will also need to include an information sheet with the pen describing the pen and who made it (example shown below). I will be running the pen exchange and if you have any questions let me know.

What is required to participate in the pen exchange:

Hand crafted pen
Information sheet included with pen
Enclosed in a wrapped package
Optional – included in the wrapped package (not required):

A couple of pen blanks A pen case (for the pen)

NEW STABILIZATION SERVICE

Malcolm Koch, a newer member from McMinnville, is an avid turner of anything small which might require use of an eccentric chuck or make lotsa noise when finished. He custom turns duck calls made from Cocobolo and color-stabilized hard, figured maple and basswood. Malcolm is making available to any member the stabilization process he uses in making the duck calls. The process uses a strong vacuum followed by a heat cure. The results you might find pleasing with some examples on display at the next meeting. Coloring is available. The basic service is \$25.00 per load plus \$3.00 per ounce of clear resin used or \$6.00 per ounce of colored resin used. Items must be small enough to fit a space 8x8x6 inches.
